ALBURY COMMUNITY SPORTS HUB – GROUP USE 2024-25

ACSH (SCIO 051926) has fantastic sports facilities which are not only available to the public and fee-paying Open Access Users, but for use by organised groups. There are four sports available – Tennis (one court also lined for Pickleball), Grass Bowls, Putting and Petanque.

Group use would include Private Parties, family gatherings, or team building with work colleagues and can accommodate exclusive use of the premises for Groups of 15 or more (see below), subject to availability (certain times are unavailable due to recurring bookings on our schedule eg coaching sessions, sports matches)

We consider a Group to be 15 (fifteen) or more users. (Fewer than 15 can be accommodated on a Pay and Play basis during public opening timeswhen access would not be exclusive.)

CHARGE FOR SOLE USE OF THE HUB (groups of 15+)

£52.50 per hour for each sport selected, price including a volunteer on duty, use of the Pavilion and includes the equipment required. You may bring food and beverages to consume in the Pavilion but there is no licence for alcohol consumption. Hot water can be provided for coffee/tea. There is an additional charge of £31.50 per hour for this use of the Pavilion.

CHILDREN'S PARTIES

ACSH provides a unique and active birthday experience for parties of 15 or more including accompanying adults*. This would be for sole use. You may bring a celebration cake, snacks, and drinks and eat in the Pavilion. The charge based on 3 hours use (2 hours of activity + 1 hour Pavilion hire) is £157.50

* We are always willing to discuss tailoring our charges to fit your needs in terms of numbers attending, facilities used, and the times required. (This would for example apply for Children's Parties of less than 15 and would NOT be for sole use.)

PLEASE NOTE - Payment will be agreed and made in advance for both Sole Use and Children's Parties (refunded should adverse weather prevent the event taking place) and subject to the satisfactory completion of a written agreement of use.
